

Management theorist Meredith Belbin devised an internationally recognised behaviour test to identify the roles that individuals would be best suited to within a team. These roles are known as 'Belbin's Team Roles' or the 'Belbin Team Inventory'. There are nine roles:

- Plant
- · Resource Investigator
- Co-ordinator
- Shaper
- Monitor Evaluator
- Team worker
- Implementer
- Completer Finisher
- Specialist
