- 1. The play is set in 1912, just before the First World War.
- 2. The play was written in 1945, towards the end of the Second World War.
- 3. long hours, cramped, dangerous working conditions and low pay
- 4. pollution and overcrowding
- 5. not allowed to vote, lower pay than men, fewer rights in marriage, the threat of poverty and social exclusion if they became pregnant outside marriage
- 6. women won the right to vote
- 7. Priestley worked as a clerk in a factory
- 8. it founded the welfare state, with free education and healthcare for all
- 9. Answers may vary Priestley's social ideals: an equal society, no class barriers, worker's rights and women's rights, fair pay, free education and healthcare, and a welfare state paid for by taxing wealthier people.
