- 3. cool atmosphere; feels ominous, threatening
- 4. the way the story is told or performed
- 5. crime fiction; thriller
- 6. tight plotting; sudden exits and entrances; secrets; dramatic irony
- 7. tight focus, atmospheric tension
- 8. In theatre, dramatic irony is where the audience is privy to knowledge that the characters in the play do not know.
- 9. a) to teach people right and wrong by showing dramatic examples of good and bad behaviour; b) Inspector Goole trying to teach them a lesson
- 10. Goole's speech is emotive and melodramatic at points; the other characters speak naturally.
